## **Reflection questions:**

- Read 2 Corinthians 1:2-3 (NLT): "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us." Reflect back on a time when you experienced God's comfort in your life. What made that time so significant to you? Has that experience better prepared you to offer comfort to others?
